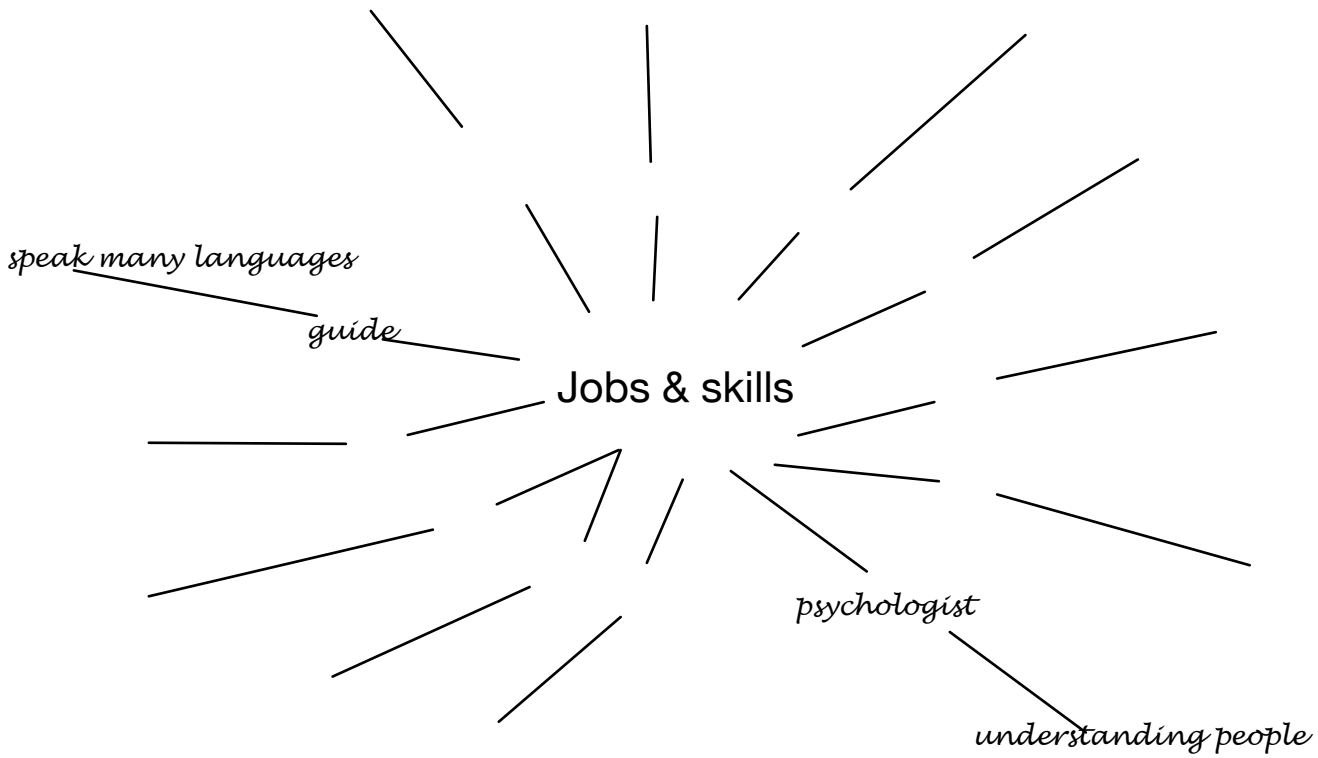

A. Brainstorm jobs and appropriate skills for each job



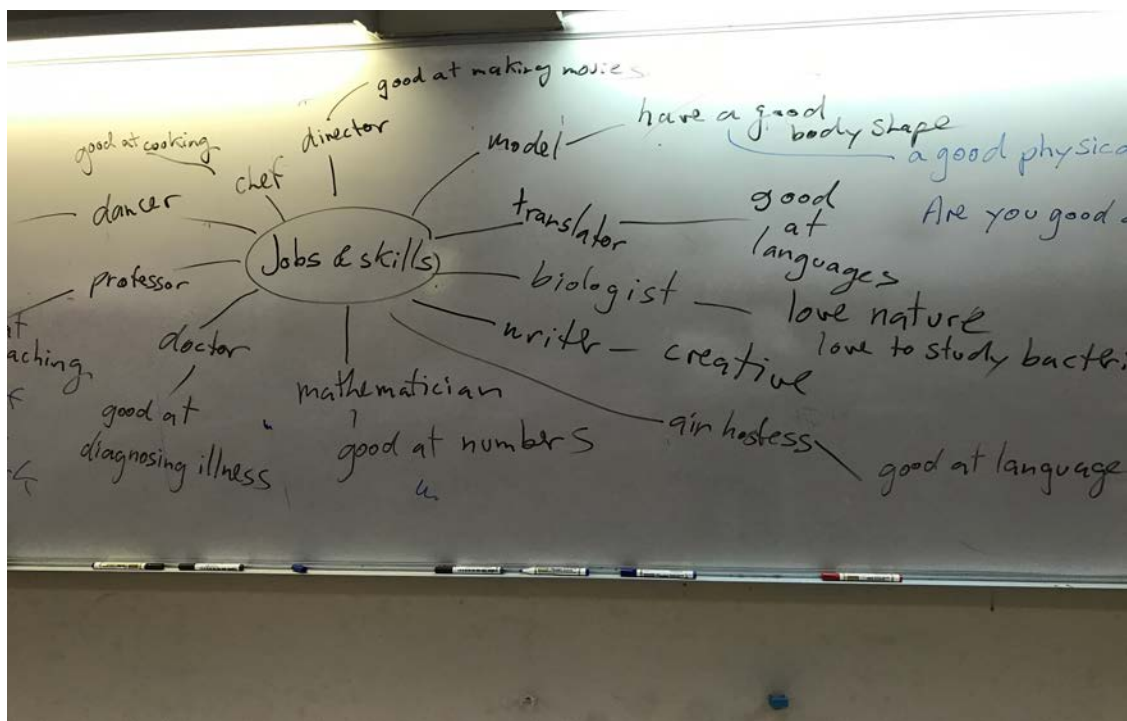
