Comparative Adjectives (possible answers)

Multiple adjectives can be applied to each pair of pictures.

1 Sofas are more comfortable than chairs/benches. (or)
Lying on a sofa is more comfortable than sitting on a sofa.

Sofas are safer than benches.

2 Text messages are more convenient than letters. (or)
Sending text messages is more convenient than sending letters.

Text messages are faster than letters.
Text messages are more modern than letters.

3 Chemistry is more interesting than math.
Studying chemistry is more interesting than studying math.

Chemistry is easier than math.

4 Picnics are more exciting than homework.
Having a picnic is more exciting than doing homework.

Homework is more useful than a picnic.

5 Outdoor sports are more dangerous than video games.
Going rock climbing is more dangerous than playing video games.

Video games are more popular than rock climbing.
