Write about a plan, prediction or scheduled event for the future for each picture.



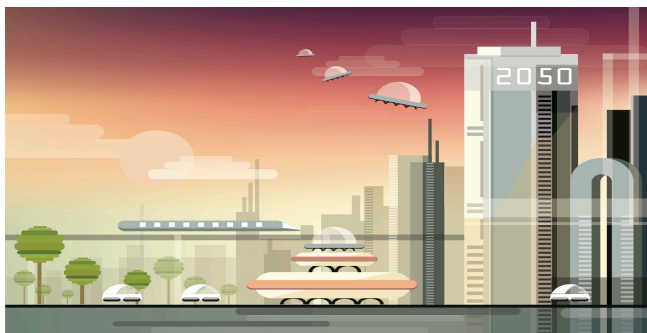

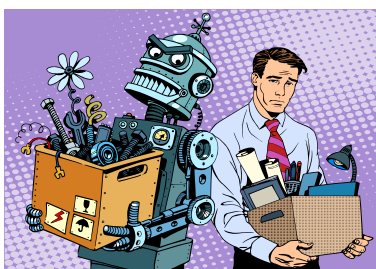
