### Exercise 1: Ranking Exercise - Easter Traditions Around the World

- E. In Australia, the Royal Easter Show is a large agricultural event featuring livestock shows, carnival rides, and a variety of food.

### Exercise 3: Pair Work Speaking Exercise - Example Answers

- What is the Easter Bunny known for? The Easter Bunny is a legendary figure that is said to bring Easter eggs and candy to children on Easter morning.
- Can you describe an egg hunt? An egg hunt is an Easter activity where children search for hidden eggs, which are often filled with candy or small prizes.
- What are hot cross buns? Hot cross buns are sweet, spiced bread rolls with a cross on the top, typically eaten during the Easter season.
- What does the resurrection represent in Christianity? The resurrection represents Jesus Christ rising from the dead after his crucifixion, symbolizing victory over sin and death.
- What happens on Palm Sunday? Palm Sunday commemorates Jesus' entry into Jerusalem, where people welcomed him by waving palm branches and placing them on the ground.
