## Movie Week Invitation Practice

Objective: Practice extending and accepting invitations using a movie schedule for a week.
Instructions: In pairs, students will take turns inviting each other to watch a movie from the provided schedule. The other student will either accept, decline or suggest another movie to watch. Make sure to use appropriate expressions for invitations, acceptance, and refusal.

Example Conversation:
Student A: Hey, I noticed that "Mystery at Moonrise Castle" is playing on Tuesday at 7:30 PM. It's a mystery film and got 4 stars. Would you like to watch it with me?

Student B: That sounds interesting, but I am busy on Tuesday. How about watching "Alien Invasion Utopia" on Thursday at 6:00 PM instead? It's a sci-fi movie with 4.5 stars.

Student A: Sure, that sounds like a great idea. Let's go watch "Alien Invasion Utopia" on Thursday!
