Follow-up: Where are you going to do this?

2. Where will you have dinner tonight?

- a) I will have dinner at home with my family.
- b) I'll be dining at a restaurant with friends.
- c) I'll grab a quick bite from a food truck.

Follow-up: What will you eat?

3. When are you going to meet your friends this week?

- a) We're going to meet on Wednesday evening.
- b) I'll meet them on Friday night.
- c) We haven't decided yet, but it will be sometime this weekend.

Follow-up: What are you planning to do?

4. Who will you visit this month?

- a) I'm planning to visit my parents.
- b) I will go see my old friend from college.
- c) I'm not sure yet, it will depend on my work schedule.

Follow-up: Where do they live?

5. Why are you going to take a vacation this year?

Follow-up: What interests you about this hobby?

2. Will you buy a new car this month?

- a) Yes, I've been saving up for a while now.
- b) No, I'm satisfied with the one I have.
- c) I'm not sure, I'm still contemplating.

Follow-up: What type of car are you considering?

3. Are you going to move to a new place this year?

- a) Yes, I'm planning to move closer to my workplace.
- b) No, I'm comfortable where I am.
- c) Maybe, if I find a better place.

Follow-up: Where would you like to move?

4. Will you take part in the marathon this year?

- a) Yes, I've been training for months.
- b) No, I don't enjoy running.
- c) Maybe, if my health permits.

Follow-up: Have you participated in a marathon before?

5. Are you going to do anything interesting on the weekend?

- a) Yes, I am planning to go hiking.
