


Label the pictures with the following vocabulary.

- 1. Panda Picture 1 shows a panda, probable in China
- 2. Hunting Picture 2 depicts a hunter, suggesting the activity of hunting.
- 3. Blue Whale Picture 3 features a blue whale.
- 4. Leopard Picture 4 shows a leopard in a snowy mountainous area.
- 5. **Drilling or Oil Rig** Picture 5 represents an oil rig, which is associated with drilling, oil spills and energy, offshore, rig
- 6. **Condor** Picture 6 depicts what appears to be a large bird, which could be a condor.
- 7. Dam Picture 7 shows a dam.
- 8. Deforestation Picture 8 illustrates the process of deforestation.
- 9. Sea Turtle Picture 9 features sea turtles, l in an ocean setting.
- 10. Rhinoceros Picture 10 shows a rhinoceros and horn, perhaps living in the Serengeti
