

Exercise 1: Which word is different?

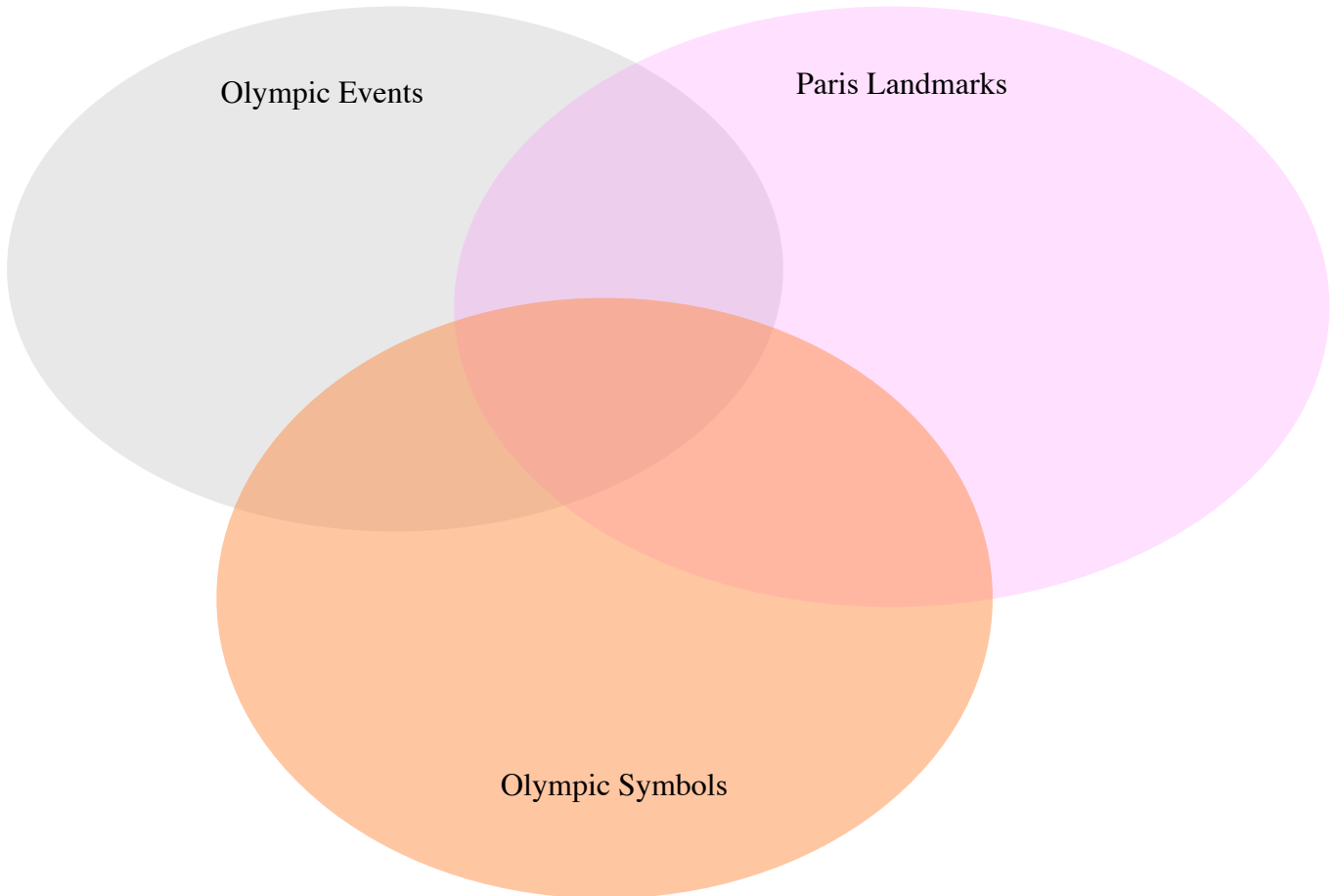
Circle the word that doesn't belong in each group. Think about why it's different.

Exercise 1: Which word is different?

1. athletics (it's a category of sports, not a specific sport like swimming or fencing)
2. bronze (it's not a precious metal like gold or silver)
3. stadium (it's not a specific Paris landmark like the Seine or Eiffel Tower)
4. medal (it's an award, while torch and anthem are ceremonial elements)
5. spectator (they watch the games, while athletes and coaches are active participants)
6. marathon (it's a specific event, while opening and closing ceremonies are general Olympic events)
7. racquet (it's used in racquet sports, while javelin and discus are thrown in track and field events)
8. world cup (it's not an Olympic event like the Olympics and Paralympics)

Exercise 2: Match the words

1. Olympic Events:
 - swimming
 - marathon
 - fencing
2. Paris Landmarks:
 - Eiffel Tower
 - Seine
 - stadium (can also be in Olympic Symbols)
3. Olympic Symbols:
 - medal
 - torch
 - gold
 - opening ceremony
 - stadium (can also be in Paris Landmarks)

Note: "athlete" and "coach" could potentially fit into Olympic Events or Olympic Symbols, depending on interpretation.
