

Future Tense Guide

Plans, Predictions, and Schedules

1. Going to (Plans and Intentions)

Usage:

- Definite plans: "I'm going to buy a house"
- Future intentions: "I'm going to start exercising"
- Decisions made before speaking: "We're going to move next month"
- Evidence-based predictions: "Look at those clouds! It's going to rain"

2. Will (Predictions and Spontaneous Decisions)

Usage:

- General predictions: "I think robots will replace some jobs"
- Spontaneous decisions: "I'll start my diet tomorrow"
- Promises: "I'll help you move"
- Future facts: "The sun will rise at 6 AM tomorrow"

3. Present Continuous (Fixed Arrangements)

Usage:

- Fixed arrangements: "I'm moving into my new apartment on the 15th"
- Scheduled events: "We're having a meeting at 2 PM"
- Personal arrangements: "I'm seeing the doctor next week"
- Travel plans: "We're flying to Paris next month"

Common Time Expressions:

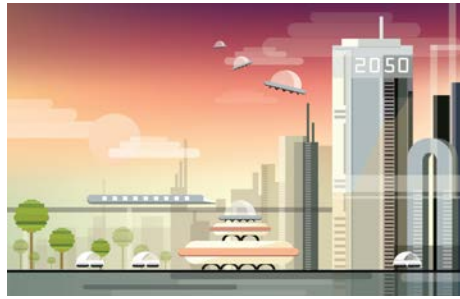
tomorrow • next week • in the future • soon • later • tonight • next month • in [time period]

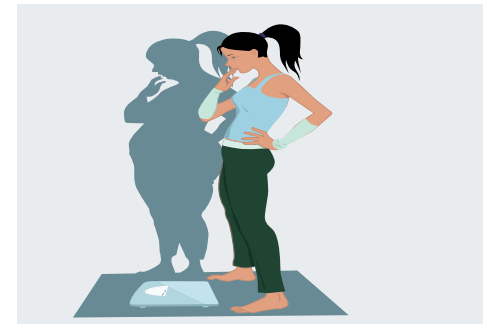

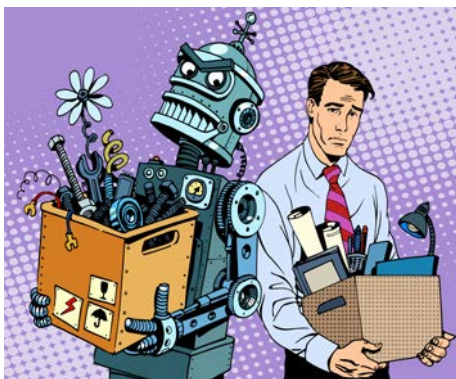
