# **Present Continuous for Future Plans**

A Guide to Talking About Future Arrangements

#### Structure:

Subject + am/is/are + verb-ing

#### Examples:

- I am meeting my cousins at 2 PM
- She is giving a cooking demo at 3 PM

## When to Use:

- Fixed arrangements and plans
- Events with a specific time and place
- Personal appointments and meetings
- Scheduled events in the near future
- Activities that are already organized

### Common Time Expressions:

this weekend

- later today
- at [time] (e.g., at 2 PM)
- on [day] (e.g., on Saturday)
- tomorrow
- next week

## **Questions and Answers:**

- Q: What are you doing this weekend?
- A: I'm going to an Indian food festival downtown.
